# OFFER N. 8/2018 – CZECH REPUBLIC RED DEER – FALLOW DEER AND MOUFLON HUNTING

### HUNTING AREA N. 1

4,500 hectares (3,500 ha are mixed forests, 450 ha are meadows and fields, 305 ha are covered with water). Hunting area is encompassed between two rivers and offers unique atmosphere of floodplain forests which are interwoven with forest channels, oxbows and pools. The forests are complemented by ancient solitary oak trees. Red deer, fallow deer and wild boar are present in this hunting grounds. The strongest red deer trophies recently reach 205-210 CIC points. Record red deer trophy is 226 CIC points.

### HUNTING AREA N. 2

2,600 hectares (2,450 ha mixed forests) with an altitude from 300 to 500 m. above sea level. Southern slopes covered with oak forests gradually change into flat hillocks which steeply descend into the valleys of two rivers. The hunting area's northern part is characterized by colder biotopes with spruce, pine and linden. Red deer, mouflon as well as wild boar are present in this hunting grounds. During the last hunting season many strong gold medal trophies of red deer were shot and some gold medal trophies of wild boars (tuskers 120-130 CIC points). The historically strongest red deer trophy was 247 CIC points.

### HUNTING AREA N. 3

1300 hectares hilly hunting grounds mainly cover with mixed forests (mainly oak, hornbeam and other broadleaf tree species). The dominant game are red deer and fallow deer, complemented with wild boar. Many trophies of red deer have reached the value of strong gold medals during the last hunting season. The record red deer trophy in these grounds is 243 CIC.

Around 500 hectares with a soft-hilly profile mainly covered with forests (oak, hornbeam and other broadleaves trees). Dominant games are mouflon, fallow deer and red deer. The strongest mouflon trophy recently hunted has reached 241 CIC Points, the strongest fallow buck 210 CIC Points and the strongest red stag 242 CIC Points.

# THE HUNTING CHATEAU



The hunting Chateau

A pleasant high standard accommodation is provided by a nice hunting Chateau. The chateau's origins date back to the 14<sup>th</sup> century when records mentioned a water stronghold built along so-called amber trade path that connected Mediterranean and Baltic coasts. During following periods the stronghold gained gradually more splendour under the possession of the local noble families. A radical transformation was carried out during XVIII century. Current classicist style of Chateau was influenced by the Archduke Friedrich, owner of the chateau at the beginning of XX century. At that time the Chateau and surrounding estates hosted hunting guest from all over the world. Rooms of the Chateau were adorned with trophies of games hunted all over the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Since 1918 the Chateau and the adjoining park have been in possession of the Czech Republic. During the 1920s and 1930s T.G. Masaryk, President of the Czechoslovakian Republic, paid several visits to the Chateau.

Park of the Chateau was established in the early 18<sup>th</sup> century and was gradually transformed into an English-style landscape garden. It covers the area of 22 hectares
